As the term progresses, we remain mindful that we continue to operate in a State of Emergency.

We remain abreast of all of the current information and follow all directives from the Department of Health and Education. These measures will protect students, staff and our community.

Thank you for continuing to wear masks when on school site and practicing recommended social distancing requirements.

All staff at Carramar Primary will continue to wear a mask. Masks can be removed when teaching or issuing instructions.

The Department's Operating Guidelines are in the process of being updated. In the interim:

- Parent support in classrooms and attendance at assemblies is deferred
- Parent interviews can take place – parents are asked to sign in and wear their mask
- Parents wishing to collect students for appointments etc are reminded to sign in
- Canteen ordering/purchasing will return to pre-lockdown
 - orders can be made on line and / or over the counter before school
 - thank you for observing social distancing and wearing a mask if ordering before school
 - children may purchase over the counter at break times
