Work-related travel restrictions

Based on travel advice released by the Department of the Premier and Cabinet, the following travel conditions apply to all staff:

Intrastate

- Staff may travel freely within the State for work-related purposes.

Interstate

- There is to be no work-related interstate travel or planning to travel in Term 3, 2021. Based on State directions, this position will be reviewed in Term 4.

International

- Staff cannot undertake any international travel for work-related purposes.

Parents allowed on school sites and in classrooms

Schools continue to operate under the [Phase 4 Operating Guidelines](#). There is no Health advice that prevents parents/families from entering school grounds including classrooms. Please ensure families are welcomed into our schools and classrooms.

- physical distancing measures still apply, including one adult per two square metres and maintaining 1.5 metres between adults, where possible. Children are not to be factored into this equation.
