

CPS COVID 19 RESPONSE PLAN 2022



As a school, we are committed to ensure all students and families are safe, and supported and if required, students will be able to continue their learning at home.

The [Carramar Primary School COVID-19 Action Plan 2022](#) will ensure all our families understand how we will support all of our staff, students and families when this occurs.

Positive COVID 19 Case

If a positive COVID 19 case is reported to the school, we will make necessary decisions with regard to the Teaching and Learning Program for the cohort/s impacted and inform the community of the learning arrangements for those cohorts.

In the first instance this will include:

1. Learning from Home hard copy work package for all students in the identified cohort/s.
2. Online Learning from Home Connect Classrooms (If the cohort is impacted further)

Close Contact

Your family may become a close contact and be directed to self-isolate for 7 days. Please refer to [Close Contact](#) Information

If your child **is** required to isolate and they are well, we encourage you to continue to access our online resources such as Reading Eggs and Mathletics, as well as [Learning from home - Department of Education](#) applicable to their year.

Your child/ren's teacher will contact you to ensure that your child/ren are participating in the learning program.

Mask Wearing

Commencing Thursday 3 March 2022, students in Year 3 and above will need to wear a mask indoors at school.

If your child is in Year 3 and above, you may wish to speak to your child about wearing a mask, and that their friends will also be wearing them.

If your child is in Kindergarten to Year 2, you may wish to let them know that they will see other children around the school wearing a mask, just like their teacher does.
