Building Resiliency In Young Children

This week, I would like to look at **resiliency**. In a world that is becoming more and more challenging, the ability to be resilient is becoming a vital skill that needs to be developed in our young people.

Resiliency is the ability to 'bounce back' after challenges or tough times. For young children, these challenges might include, learning to tie shoelaces or write their name, starting a new school, moving house, being bullied, or family breakdown, illness or death. When things don't go well, some children feel anxious, disappointed, afraid or frustrated. Resilience helps children to understand that these emotions usually don't last forever. A resilient child is more likely to face problems and deal with them in healthy ways instead of becoming aggressive or defensive. They are more likely to have better physical and mental health than a child who struggles with resilience.

As parents and teachers, we want our children to be able to recover from setbacks and get on with life. So what can we do to build resilience in our young children? There are things that we can do to help and support our children to learn these skills. Here are just a few:

- Help your child to build good relationships with others, including adults and peers.
- Be a role model to your child. Try to model 'healthy thinking' when facing your own challenges. Talk out loud the thought processes that help you to solve a problem.
- Build your child's independence.
- Model gratitude. What did someone do today to make you happy? What did you do today to make someone else happy? What have you learned today?
- Try not to solve all your child's minor problems or disappointment. For example, ask your child what they might do if they forget their lunchbox.
- Encourage your child to have another go when things don't work out the first time. Recognise their effort and/or participation.
- Teach your child self-care. For example, talk about activities that keep you calm (going for a walk, drinking water, listening to a story or drawing). Help your child to recognise what is and isn't in your control.
- Talk to your child about their emotions. Help them to identify, express and manage their emotions.
- Find a positive role model who has experienced similar challenges.
- Teach your child to problem-solve. For example, if a child at school has said or done something unkind, brainstorm how your child might respond next time. If your child is feels left out of a friendship group, help them to develop a plan. Remind your child of all the people around who can help.



- Being bored is not necessarily bad for children. Your child might come up with their own ideas of what to do.
- Make time to recognise and acknowledge when things are going well.

Children develop resiliency over time. There is no quick fix. Try to be patient and supportive while your child works out how to respond to challenges. You may want to jump in and fix everything straight away for your child, but occasionally allow your child to go through uncomfortable feelings so that they can work things out for themselves. In that way, you are helping to build their resiliency.



Supporting Children to Transform their Anxiety into Resilience

Workshop Overview

Changes that occur through family separation can trigger anxiety in many children and teens. Sometimes the anxiety can take a hold and erode self-esteem, belief in themselves and their engagement in the world.

Anxiety can manifest in many different forms - a child having trouble staying focused, is unmotivated, has difficulty sleeping, or just downright angry. The good news is that anxiety is manageable, important adults in a child's life have the profound capacity to strengthen children and teens against anxiety.

The **2-hour** workshop discusses ways parents and caregivers can help children and teens with the underlying challenges of anxiety and equip them with a mindset, skills, and qualities to develop resilience through the difficult time of family separation.


